The program ends with a master thesis (Svilen Kunev, PhD, Miroslava Boneva, PhD) which has to integrate the achievements of all the studied subjects.

The master program "Entrepreneurship and innovation" is appropriate for students who:

- (1) Want to create their own company on their own, a family based company or in a partnership;
- (2) Already have their own business on their own, a family based company or in a partnership;
- (3) Want to work in private or public structures in assistance to the SME's.

For students who have studied business the training is 2 semesters and for everyone else it is 4 semesters. The training is part-time presence and it takes place only Saturday and Sunday. The semester fees are considerably lower than the consultants' fees which would give you the same answers. You can send questions to the Coordinator of the master program assoc. prof.
